Unanimously agreed.

ELECTION TO THE VILLAGE HALL COMMITTEE (1 Member)

Paul Riddle was proposed by Mrs Miller. Seconded by Mrs Buck. Unanimously agreed.

ELECTION TO THE PLAYING FIELD COMMITTEE (1 Member)

Neil Rogers was proposed by Mrs Buck Seconded by Mrs Camp. Unanimously agreed.

CONTRIBUTION TO THE UPKEEP OF THE NEW CHURCHYARD

In 2012 and 2013 a contribution of £300 each year had been made, double the amount given in 2012. ~~11~~

Although this is not an obligatory contribution, an increasing donation has been made for many years.

It was agreed, to give £300 again this year but to bear in mind a possible additional contribution during the year if funds permit.

APPOINTMENT OF INTERNAL EXAMINER.

The pre-audit examination of the accounts had been carried out by David Binderfeld on 1st May and found satisfactory.
